A Rhodes Scholar, he was invited to York University in 1992 as the first George R. Gardiner Professor of Business Ethics. He founded the Canadian Chapter of Transparency He is also Project Director and Principal Investigator for the International. Canadian Business Ethics Research Network (CBERN), located in the Schulich School of Business. Dr. Cragg has published widely in Canadian and international journals and written and edited a number of books. A recent research theme is mining, economic development and Aboriginal communities particularly those located in the Canadian North.
